- [Page 6-7: Details about the categories](#)

Before: **4. Harmonisation at an international level**

After: **4. Product categories**

More details were added about each category to broaden the understanding of the product range covered by our standard (4.1 Cosmetics & Wellness – 4.2 Detergents – 4.3 Air Fresheners – 4.4 Sea Salt).

- [Page 12: Tightening up of environmental criteria](#)

In the **3. Minimal environmental impact while in use**, the “Dosing instructions” are no longer recommended, but clearly stated in Part III.

Before: **4. Low level toxicity** and **5. Good biodegradability** were not compulsory

After: You will find the criteria details in Part II and III.

Also, a **7. Substances of very high concern (SVHC) and microplastic** was added, stating that the use of substances of very high concern (according to REACH and microplastic is not allowed).

- [Page 13: Details about derogations](#)

Before: **2. Nature of the processes used**

After: **2. Derogations** (Nature of the processes used is now **3.**)

More details were provided about the derogation types and processes to obtain one.

- [Page 15: Details about traceability](#)

Traceability was **5.** and is now the **6.**

Details were added regarding the traceability processes used, and documents needed to prove that the company meets the legal regulations.

- [Page 15: Tightening up about cleaning and disinfection](#)

Separation from non-ecological products was **6.** and is now the **7.**

Before: The requirements regarding the cleaning and disinfection were not compulsory.

After: Two rules to follow regarding cleaning and disinfection.

- Page 16: More details about packaging materials

Packaging was **7.** and is now the **8.**

Before: **7.1 General points** was rather blurry

After: **8.1 General points** is now filled with details about the materials allowed for the products.

- Page 19: More details about the use of the label

The first paragraph of **1. Operators** explains the differences between direct and indirect users of the label.

- Removal of the first appendix

In the old version, page 27 was the first appendix *"LIST OF FOREIGN CERTIFICATION BODIES AND STANDARDS THAT ARE APPROVED BY PROBILA-UNITRAB FOR APPLICATIONS IN COSMETICS AND THAT MIGHT BE APPROVED FOR APPLICATIONS IN WASHING PRODUCTS."*

This appendix was removed, because it was not relevant anymore.
