Equivalence Agreement between Canada and the European Union

The RE BIO EU (RE 2018/848) is equivalent with the COR (*Canadian Organic Regime*).

ARE COVERED BY THAT EQUIVALENCE :

-  Products grown/raised in the European Union
-  Processed food products with ingredients grown in the EU
-  Processed food products whose ingredients have been imported into the EU in accordance with the EU
-  Wine products labelled "organic wine"

Labelling

Organic products destined for export to Canada must be labelled in accordance with the equivalence agreements

3 product categories in Canada :

-  Organic (>95% organic ingredients)
-  Contains organic ingredients (between 70% and 95% organic ingredients)
-  Identification of organic ingredients ONLY in the list of ingredients (< 70% organic ingredient)

For information, the 100% organic label (100% ORGANIC) does not exist.
